DOUBLE SCOOP dueled early from outside, took charge on the far turn, opened a clear lead approaching the stretch then drew off while being ridden out. CITY SISTER settled early, rallied four wide on the turn, closed the gap in upper stretch but was no match for the sinner. MISS CAP was outrun for a half, rallied four wide leaving the turn then failed to threaten while improving her position. SAINTLY ACTION sluggish early, was outrun for a half, raced in traffic behind a wall of horses at the top of the stretch, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. REIGN OF TARA was taken in hand along the inside while in traffic along the backstretch, angled out while gaining on the turn then flattened out. ANN DEAR raced very wide while far back through the turn, advanced nine wide into the stretch then passed tiring horses. DANDY ROSE checked in traffic on the far turn and was never close thereafter. BEL BAIE raced between horses for a half and faltered. VIBS set the early pace inside the winner and gave way on the turn.
