Footnotes

SILVER WAGON raced in good position along the inside, slipped through along the rail to take charge in upper stretch and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. GOING WILD bobbled slightly at the start, raced just behind the pacesetter, closed the gap while angling three wide on the turn, made a brief run to threaten at the top of the stretch, but was no match for the winner. DASHBOARD DRUMMER bumped at the start, raced just off the pace for a half and lacked the needed response when called upon. SAINT DAIMON opened a wide gap in the early stages, set the pace along the inside for a half and tired in the final eighth. TENTHIRTEEN steadied between horses along the backstretch, swung five wide on the turn and failed to mount a serious late charge. STOLEN TIME chased four wide for a half and tired. PAVO was pinched back then ducked out along the backstretch and trailed throughout.
