COLLAR sprinted clear, shook loose on the turn, maintained a clear advantage into midstretch and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the late stages. SMART TRADE was outrun early, circled four wide while gaining at the quarter pole and finished strongly but could not get up. CREMA D'ORO checked along the inside on the far turn, waited while saving ground on the turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished willingly. PEA STONE was reserved early, rallied four wide to threaten at the quarter pole and flattened out. GOLDEN ARTEMIS pressed early along the rail and gave way on the turn. FLYING SAPPHO was outrun after breaking slowly. TREAT HER RIGHT steadied in traffic at the half mile pole and gave way.
