MOSHE DIANE recovered in quick order after stumbling at the start, dueled from the inside with SOLDIERETTE, with both horses trying to keep something in reserve, had MAGDALENA GIRL join up from the three path leaving the half mile pole, began to edge away from both heading for the top of the lane, spurted away after being set down in upper stretch, then held sway while being kept to the task at hand. SONG OF BROADWAY tracked the pace skirmish from the inside, bided her time until nearing the quarter pole, angled outward after entering the stretch, split rivals around the three-sixteenths pole, was outfinished during the last eighth, but held well to procure the place. MAGDALENA GIRL perched three wide off the early activity, advanced to make a bid for the lead departing the half mile pole, kept up the pursuit until the quarter pole before flattening out. FRAZZIE broke a bit behind the field after stumbling at the start, moved up to rejoin the pack, steadied between rivals at several points during the run down the backstretch, swung four wide into the stretch but lacked a solid kick. SOLDIERETTE disputed the pace from the two path for a half and gave way. HOLDME KAZ off a beat slowly, raced three wide and tired. PEARL RIVER the first to pop out of the starting gate, dropped back to rear of the pack in a hurry, underwent a four wide journey and folded.
