GIANT SURPRISE went head to head with OFFICER PRADO for a few strides before edging away, cut the pace from the inside, with the previously mentioned foe in hot pursuit, was let out turning for home and kicked clear, lengthened away during the last eighth, kept busy to the end, then was vanned off after the finish. OFFICER PRADO placed in the two path soon after the start, was coaxed along prompting the pacesetter, continued along on the same scenario throughout the opening half, got called upon issuing a challenge coming to the quarter pole, was shaken off, then just fended off INVOCATION to preserve the place. INVOCATION off a beat slowly, made it into midpack after being put to some encouragement, ducked over to the inside after clearing a rival coming to the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner under a full drive, was kept to it and missed second. STEALCASE bobbed at the break, settled toward the inside in time for the run around the bend, tracked the front runners being asked for some run all the while to keep pace, angled outward, eventually making it into the three path at the head of the stretch, made up some ground late on the turn, but soon flattened out. TIMELY TALLY placed five wide at the top of the lane, lacked the necessary response. DIXIE MINISTER three wide at the half mile pole, was through after completing a half. DOCTORIOUS left the backstretch four wide, folded. A CAT THAT FLIES faded off a ground-saving journey. LOSTANDFOUNDAGAIN raced three on the turn and tired.
