COUNTKNICKERBOCKER contested the pace on the outside, inched clear outside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. VERDE MONT was forced in just after the start, raced well back in the field, saved ground early on the turn, angled four wide outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well but was too late. DREAMSGONEWILD contested the pace on the inside of the winner, vied inside on the turn, moved out after losing contact with the aforementioned rival and was outfinished while able to get the show. BIG GUY was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and lacked the needed kick. LAKOTA FREUD chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong and weakened then pulled up in heat distress after the race. SOLENKO was ridden along on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and tired. WINNING PAL was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed kick. SUNSHAWN bumped with a rival in the early going, was hard ridden towards the back, raced three wide on the turn, moved out in the final furlong, lacked room nearing the wire and failed to threaten. CALYPSO BOB bumped with a rival early, was urged along while off the pace, had a bit of trouble cornering on the turn, moved to five wide outside the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. IRISH HUMOR bumped with rivals on both sides early,

chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and gave way. BARNARDS GALAXY raced well back in the field and showed little. JOHNNIES LAST BURN broke two lengths behind the field, was urged along at the back, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor.
