SUNNY DESERT was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came between rivals nearing the quarter-pole, dropped to the inside after straightening for the drive, rallied under right hand urging, gained the lead passing the sixteenth pole then edged clear under good handling. EASY ENDING came away in good order, showed good speed, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even with the pacesetter while three wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail shortly thereafter, shook clear outside the five-sixteenths pole, was put a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished but gamely held the place. FIFTYFOUR FOREVER chased the pace while off the rail, dropped to the inside leaving the backstretch, shifted three wide outside the five-sixteenths pole, pursued EASY ENDING into upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip, made a bid near the furlong marker, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the place. MYRTLE'S GRAY was bumped by SHE'S FIRED UP at the start then bumped the hindquarters of LENDERS WAY and was squeezed back, raced on the outside while ridden along, went four wide on the turn, came under left hand urging in upper stretch, drifted out nearing the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip and failed to rally. LENDERS WAY was bumped in the hindquarters just after the start, raced on the outside while just off the pace, went four wide on the turn, dropped in a bit at the top of the stretch, was asked for her absolute best and weakened. SHE'S FIRED UP bumped MYRTLE'S GRAY at the start then dropped back under left rein pressure, fell well behind and was no factor. TWO MOONS was hustled from the start, set the pace under pressure, lost the lead near the three-eighths pole, dropped out approaching the five-sixteenths pole and faded.
