WILLY PAY settled off the pace while on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the turn, floated six wide while gaining into the stretch, rallied on the far outside, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker then drew away under a drive. TOWERING lacked early speed, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and got up for the place. ORIGINAL ART pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, took the lead coming to the quarter-pole, inched clear under the whip in upper stretch, was collared inside the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. STORMY ACRE was void of speed, went two to three wide on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and improved position. BACKDOWN was hustled from the start, drifted out leaving the chute, set the pace under pressure while well off the inside, drifted a bit further out in the vicinity of the half-mile pole, dropped in leaving the backstretch, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead near the quarter-pole and tired. SMART FARDA was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came off the inside in upper stretch, moved out behind rivals in the final furlong and failed to rally. FLAPSUP chased the pace on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and tired. POKER POWER was ridden along in the back half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. WISE GUY CHARLIE chased the pace, dropped back between rivals outside the half-mile pole, went three

wide on the turn and came up empty. DIXIE MINISTER was restless in the gate then hustled from the start, chased the pace, moved in near the half-mile pole, was hard ridden while off the rail on the turn and had nothing left. CAT MAN FU raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. TRICKEY GUY settled while under some urging, dropped to the rail midway through the turn and failed to respond.
