Footnotes

LA PERNELLE (IRE) three wide in midpack in a tightly bunched field all under rating tactics, was set down at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, traded light bumps with ARCH SUPPORT at the three-sixteenths while under a drive as that foe looked for a clear lane from off the rail, kept on with good energy splitting foes at the sixteenth marker, seized command in the final strides to prevail at the wire in a blanket finish where no rival was soundly defeated. PRIZE CATCH three wide under a firm hold towards the rear, was the first of the field to come under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, swung four wide for home, held the lane rightfully hers as FEDERATION made a failed attempt to bull her way out at the three-sixteenths receiving a sound bump for her effort, rallied with good energy down the outside, drifted in late on in the final strides under off sided stick work jostling the eventual winner lightly which in turn resulted in SURE ROUTE being taken in hand when squeezed out near the finish and just missed. IN THE SLIPS just off the inside towards the rear, was let out at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, shifted out one path as rivals traded bumps in front, rallied with good late energy down the center of the course for the show honors arriving on the scene in the last few strides the sole member detached from the blanket of traffic which jammed up the inner lanes near the wire. FEDERATION (GB) hard held inside from the get go, was given some rein to work with nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide for home, attempted to shift out at the three-sixteenths into the path occupied by PRIZE CATCH and was bumped soundly for it, lacked a clear path to rally through the lane shifting inside and out steadily looking for a seam until the sixteenth marker, finally found a lane in the four path, got spirited up and burst through with a strong kick and just missed. VIVO PER LEI attended the pacemaker from the three path early on, opted to the two path into the far turn, was let out at the quarter pole, took command at the three-sixteenths narrowly, battled through the length of the stretch with her pace rival, kept on to the line getting outfinished in the last few strides as a host of foes kicked on in a blanket finish. THE UNDERLING set the pace well rated inside while accompanied, was let out at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane, got headed at the three-sixteenths, fought on through the entirety of the lane holding well to the end when outfinished near the wire. SURE ROUTE (GB) just off the pace in the two path, was set down at the five-sixteenths, shifted to the three path at the three-sixteenths for a clear path, offered up a good kick in between foes in contention through the lane, was taken in hand nearing the finish when squeezed between foes as PRIZE CATCH drifted in late under off sided stick work. ARCH SUPPORT bobbled at the start, sat in reserve midpack just off the inside, came under a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, offered up a good kick while out kicked late on, lacked optimal clearance at the wire.
