PROUD ACCOLADE dueled early along the rail, shook loose leaving the turn, opened a comfortable advantage in upper stretch then drew off to a lengthy score while being kept to the task. MORE THAN SOMEWHAT was outrun early while saving ground, moved out on the turn, angled four wide at the top of the stretch then closed late to gain the place. BELARION never far back, split rivals to challenge on the turn then weakened under pressure in the final sixteenth. ELDER raced far back to the top of the stretch, advanced four wide into the stretch then rallied mildly. BARDSTOWN pressed the pace while three wide into upper stretch and weakened. AL JOHNSTAN never reached contention after breaking slowly. SUPER TUSCAN raced just off the pace while five wide along the backstretch, continued wide while gaining on the turn then flattened out. DENNISTON was never a factor while racing wide. WILD ABOUT JON raced within striking distance while four wide for a half and faltered. GOLD MINISTER raced greenly after breaking slowly. SYNC never reached contention while racing wide. DRAIMAN showed brief speed while between horses and gave way on the far turn. CHATHAM STRAIT saved ground to no avail after breaking slowly.
