WONDER AGAIN settled in good position in the early stages, raced just off while pace while saving ground along the backstretch, waited patiently while continuing to save ground on the turn, slipped through along the inside to take charge in upper stretch then drew off under a vigorous hand ride. RISKVERSE raced in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, launched a rally three wide on the run, closed the gap in upper stretch and finished willingly to clearly best the others. OCEAN DRIVE was rated just behind the early leader, steadily gained in the two path on the turn, made a run to challenge approaching the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. SAND SPRINGS sprinted clear in the early stages, extended her lead along the backstretch, set the pace for seven furlongs, drifted off the rail while battling heads apart at the top of the stretch and weakened from her early efforts. INTERCONTINENTAL (GB) was taken well back in the early stages, trailed for nearly a half, gained some ground while four wide nearing the far turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. SPICE ISLAND failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground throughout. HALORY LEIGH was outrun for six furlongs, swung three wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing response.
