Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2004 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2003 or Grade 2 in 2004, 4 lbs.; \$50,000; or three races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming or restricted allowance races not considered). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 17, 2004 with 26 Nominations.





SOCIETY SELECTION checked slightly while breaking outward at the start, raced far back through the opening quarter, rapidly closed the gap while rallying five wide on the turn, charged past FOREST MUSIC to take command in upper stretch then drew away under steady left hand encouragement. BENDING STRINGS trailed along the backstretch, was outrun while racing wide for a half, circled six wide while gaining at the top of the stretch then closed late in the middle of the track to best the others. FOREST MUSIC sprinted clear soon after the start, extended her lead midway on the turn, set the pace along the inside into upper stretch and weakened from her early efforts. FRIENDLY MICHELLE ducked out along the backstretch, raced well back while five wide to the turn then failed to threaten while improving her position. PROSPECTIVE SAINT settled just off the early pace, took up chase after the leader in the two path on the turn then faded in the stretch. ELUSIVE DIVA raced in the middle of the pack between horses and lacked the needed response when called upon. DAZZLE ME raced up close along the rail for five furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. SHE'S A MUGS bumped at the start, raced five wide to the turn, checked while bumping with BENDING STRINGS at the top of the stretch and lacked a further response. REFOREST steadied behind a tiring rival on the far turn and failed to mount a serious rally thereafter. HUMOR ME MOLLY was never a factor while four wide. FELINE STORY bumped at the start, checked between horses on the far turn, never reached contention. RODEO LICIOUS pressed the early pace along the rail then took up in tight while giving way on the far turn.
