WILLARD STRAIGHT was outrun early, advanced outside on the backstretch, rallied three wide on the second turn, reached the front passing the eighth pole then dug in determinedly and held off CONTROL TOWER for the win. CONTROL TOWER was rated along inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely outside. MASS MEDIA contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. MILKY WAY GUY contested the pace from the outside and tired in deep stretch. PROUD MAN was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. CLASS CONCERN raced close up along the inside, saved ground and lacked a rally. OLD FORESTER raced three wide on the first turn, four wide on the second turn and tired in the stretch.
