Footnotes

ANDROMEDA'S HERO was strung out four wide on the first turn, continued wide while just off the pace along the backstretch, was under the whip midway on the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch then closed gradually under strong left hand urging to wear down BANK PRESIDENT in the final strides. BANK PRESIDENT angled quickly to the rail after taking the lead in the early stages, set the pace under mild pressure along the backstretch, shook loose leaving the turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and yielded late. SPRING HOUSE trailed for six furlongs while racing three wide, angled five wide entering the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. MISTO QUENTE (BRZ) pressed the pace in the two path for seven furlongs and weakened. DR. ROCKETT failed to mount a serious rally while slightly off the rail throughout. WILKO raced inside for six furlongs while just behind the leaders and gave way on the turn.
