ARCODORO away in good order, established control soon after the start, was rated setting the fractions towards the inside, continued to show the way around the second turn, now being lightly coaxed along, and still uncontested, was set down a drive upon reaching the head of the stretch, spurted away to a comfortable advantage by midstretch, then held safely while being kept to the task at hand. MORNING LINE ducked outward at the start, bumping into BRAVO WHISKEY, assumed a forward position during the straightaway run leading to the opening bend, went out to the three path soon after settling into the backstretch, remained out there, was asked to pick up the pace at the five-sixteenths pole, but made minimal progress on the leader, continued onward after turning for home, managed to make up some ground during the last eighth on the now weakening winner, but had to settle for second. HEART BUTTE bumped at the start, was reserved for nearly six furlongs, finished willingly, outkicking mainly weak ones during the stretch run to be along for the show. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL in midpack along the outside, ducked inward, taking advantage of a clear alleyway leading into the stretch, advanced forward, cutting the corner into the stretch, altered course back to the outside at the eighth pole and continued on mildly to earn a major share. TOP IT off a beat slowly, improved position by weak and tired rivals during the stretch drive. RAVEN HAWK was no factor. TWO BRASH chased the leader from the two path, was asked for a response on the far turn but backed off. BRAVO WHISKEY bumped from both sides at the break, saved ground and tired. ECONOMIC SWOON was rank during the opening stages, appearing to resist the rating tactics being applied by the rider, acted more kindly upon entering the backstretch, accompanied the pacesetter from the outside, was put to a prolonged drive and tired. GALLANT FIELDS off a bit awkwardly, raced three wide around the second turn, was through after completing three-quarters.
