Footnotes

QUEENS OR BETTER away well sat perched three wide just off the front runners, shadowed CITY VICE outward an additional path late on the turn, issued a challenge from there coming to the quarter pole, fought her way past a pair to take charge by the eighth pole, kicked clear during the final furlong under good handling. SWEET PENNY right on the heels of SEATTLE DYNASTY after the start, was allowed to ease back slightly nearing the end of the backstretch, sat a patient pocket while rating kindly, availed of room to squeeze into the two path just prior to the quarter pole, responded positively when given her cue, kept pace with the top one during the ensuing furlong before being shaken off, continued on willingly to secure second. CITY VICE left alertly and grabbed a forward position, pressed the leader while racing along the outside, drifted out just enough to provide wiggle space for the runner up to angle off the rail late on the turn, held her ground well down the lane to take the show. SEATTLE DYNASTY got off a sharp beginning, set the pace from the rail, with CITY VICE in close pursuit from the outside, came under pressure from a trio of rivals nearing the quarter pole, succumbed to the pressure a furlong down the road and steadily weakened thereafter. AUGUST GALA tucked along the inside soon after leaving the starting gate, cut the corner under a drive, lacked the necessary response. CITY LOOK raced along the outside, was urged on the turn but could make no headway on the front runners. WARRIOR MARIE three to four wide down the backstretch and around the bend, had the rider applying a strong grip on left side of the rein while appearing to try to get out, did so once she hit the stretch, drifting outward throughout the stretch drive, ignoring the best efforts used by the pilot to keep her on a truer course. BLUE SIXTY FOUR broke slowly, spotting the field several lengths at the break, rode the rail thereafter, was under brisk encouragement in the stretch, failed to reach a contending position. STORMIN ESTHER offered little. JODA'S TEN inward a step or two at the start, was grabbed hold, steadied soon

afterwards, too close to AUGUST GATE as that opponent was tucking over to the inside, losing some ground and momentum as a result, was placed in the two path and settled into stride, was guided back to the inside in time for the run around the bend, tired after completing a half.
