Footnotes

PROFESSOR FATE drifted in after the start, bumped with a rival, brushed with KING AND CRUSADER early then was taken up, was ridden along in the middle of the field, raced towards the inside while hard ridden on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed well while lugging in under left hand urging, gained the lead inside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under good handling. SILVER MAX broke in and hit the gate, bumped with a rival after the start, chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn, drifted out under left hand urging outside the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a right-handed whip and finished willingly while second best. BUNKER'S LEDGE angled in after the start, showed good speed, dueled on the outside, inched clear under a right-handed whip at the top of the stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while able to hold the show. YONDER 'TIS broke in at the start, dropped well back in the field, went two then three wide on the turn, moved out five wide at the top of the stretch, was corrected while near the heels of a rival outside the three-sixteenths pole, gained ground under left hand urging and finished with good energy but reached his best stride too late. MOREFORYOURMONEY dueled on the outside of BUNKER'S LEDGE, dropped behind that rival at the top of the stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. KING AND CRUSADER leaned out and hit the gate at the start, drifted in and brushed with PROFESSOR FATE, brushed again with that rival in the early going, chased the pace between horses, raced off the rail on the turn, came four wide at the top of the stretch, moved inside of SILVER MAX when that rival drifted out outside the three-sixteenths pole, drifted in under right hand urging in the vicinity of the furlong marker, was switched to a left-handed whip and tired. AFLEET BANDIT came in at the start then was corrected by the rider, was urged along while off the pace, dropped back while green near the half-mile pole, continued green into the turn, swerved over heels at that

point, went four wide on the turn and was no factor. TWO AND TWENTY was ridden along towards the back, raced three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail into the stretch and failed to threaten. SEAWALKER brushed with a rival at the start, moved in while well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention. ENRICO PALLAZZO was hustled from the start, chased the pace on the outside, dropped back while four wide on the turn and came up empty. LIONATOR brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, moved to the far outside and was pulled up then vanned off.
