Footnotes

HYPHER was bumped in the hindquarters in the early going, raced just behind the leaders while under a hold, bided his time while a bit off the rail on the far turn, waited off heels at the top of the stretch, dove between rivals shortly thereafter to make a bid, battled gamely with VERSAILLES ROAD in the final furlong and won a head-bobbing decision. VERSAILLES ROAD broke in at the start, went two then three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back while in hand, advanced three then four wide when given some free rein on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied under a drive to make a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled gamely with HYPHER in the final furlong, held the lead late but was denied. BWANA BRAVE was reserved while off the rail, bided his time on the far turn, was caught behind traffic into the stretch, came between rivals while roused near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly for the show. BISHOP OF NOLA was fractious in the gate, contested the pace on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out under a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch, was switched to a right-handed whip, battled into the final furlong and weakened. DON'T FOOLI HOULI raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, was carried out a bit at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and tired. PERFECT JOISKI raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. TIME TRIAL was carried in at the start then bumped with a rival, raced under a snug hold while off the rail on the initial turn, continued reserved towards the back, waited at the rear while saving ground on the far turn, was asked while behind rivals in upper stretch, eased off the inside nearing the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. TWOJOHNSANDAJACK settled on the inside, moved closer while continuing to save ground on the far turn, came under urging at the top of the stretch, was in tight briefly when HYPHER came in near the three-sixteenths

pole then also lacked the needed response. UPPER AFLEET contested the pace on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into the final furlong and gave way. MIDDLE OF THE NITE was restless in the gate, went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, was blocked behind horses in upper stretch then dropped out. (Rail at 9 Feet)
