Footnotes

SIDNEY'S CANDY came away in good order, was allowed by his rivals to stroll to the lead, set the pace with an easy advantage through dawdling fractions, controlled the tempo through the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, accelerated further clear when put to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, held a clear advantage into the final furlong and proved best under steady urging. MORYBA (BRZ) tracked the solo leader while off the rail, was asked to pick it up with three furlongs to run, followed SIDNEY'S CANDY into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, chased in the final furlong and failed to reach the winner while second best. BEAU CHOIX bumped with TURALLURE nearing the first turn, settled on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, glided along the rail on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly for the show. BLUES STREET raced near the inside on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, moved closer while inside on the far turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked while behind a rival in upper stretch, had room between horses in the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. TURALLURE bumped with BEAU CHOIX nearing the first turn then was taken in hand, raced on the outside while under some restraint, was asked on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed kick. PARIS VEGAS dropped back after the start, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, ducked in near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. VOODOO SWINGE threw his head while resisting the rating tactics of the rider in the early going, went three wide on the first turn, threw his head again midway down the backstretch, was ridden along with the whip while three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at 9 Feet)
