Footnotes

HYPHER dropped in early and caused QUICK CASABLANCA to clip his heels, was well placed along the rail, came off the inside entering the final turn, was driven four wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, kicked clear under a drive and proved best under a right-handed whip. SIDE ROAD raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled along the rail, was asked with five-sixteenths to run, came off the rail late on the final turn, swung four wide into the stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong while under the whip and finished with good courage while second best. QUICK CASABLANCA (CHI) was taken up when the winner came in early then clipped heels and bobbled, lost position along the rail on the initial turn, eventually settled towards the rear while saving ground, was asked late on the third turn, cut the corner into the stretch, advanced into third position, pursued the top two and lacked the needed response while clear for the show. HARRODS CREEK chose the three path on the first turn, disputed the pace on the outside, tracked while three wide on the second turn, continued to track outside on the backstretch, made a bid while two to three wide on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. STAR CHANNEL brushed the outside of the gate at the start then bobbled a bit, lagged at the rear while saving ground, came off the rail late on the second turn, continued near the back, was roused while four wide on the final turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and improved position. DANNHAUSER was reluctant to load, went three then two wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced off the rail on the second turn, was roused while three wide on the final turn, steadied briefly outside the quarter-pole, dropped to one off the rail shortly thereafter and failed to rally. ROYAL BENCH (IRE) went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three wide on the second turn, continued on the outside, chased three then four wide on the final turn and capitulated. SANDYINTHESUN settled on the outside while near the back, raced off the rail on the first two turns, continued towards the rear, steadied off heels entering the final turn, went three wide on that turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. ADDRESS UNKNOWN (GB) was rated towards the front while off the rail, dropped back late on the backstretch and came up empty. ALBURJ contested the pace on the inside, moved clear on the second turn, continued in front through reasonable fractions, came under urging with a half-mile to run, was put to the whip leaving the backstretch, vied inside on the final turn and gave way. (Rail at 18 Feet)
