DANCING HOUSE was taken hold after getting carried in slightly by MAGSAMELIA at the start, took up position in midpack racing from off the inside, was between rivals for a good portion of the way around the bend, was given her cue and proceeded to angle outward leaving the five-sixteenths marker until four wide a sixteenth later, started to settle into her best stride nearing the eighth pole, closed enough ground to loom boldly in the late stages, grabbed away the decision from QUILT right near the wire. QUILT contently tracked the front runners while sitting in the pocket, got asked for a response after reaching the quarter pole, was taken out several paths during the initial portion of the stretch run, left the sixteenth pole and was soon battling for command from between rivals, poked a head down in front for a jump, only to get headed by the eventual winner right afterwards. MAGSAMELIA came in sharply, taking the top one along for an abbreviated ride, prompted the pacesetter from the two path, willingly moved one path wider for the commencement of the stretch imitating the movement of PROVE IT ALL NIGHT to being two wide at that stage, responded with good energy, edging away from the others to arrive at the furlong marker with none latched on, had the first two finishers breathing down hard by a sixteenth later, got overhauled in the final seventy yards and had to settle for the show. OCEAN BOULEVARD tucked along the rail with room to spare before reaching the end of the backstretch, briefly vacated it coming to the head of the stretch only to re-tuck along the rail once QUILT was herself swung outward, lacked the needed response to threaten for an in-the-money finish. PROVE IT ALL NIGHT shook away from the others to take the early advantage, was sent over to the rail, cut the pace from there, with the rider applying a strong grip on the left rein, resulting in the head tilted noticeably in the same direction, had the hold relaxed coming to the quarter pole getting asked for some run as MAGAMELIA was ranging up dangerously, drifting into the two path for the start of the stretch drive, yielded soon afterwards and steadily backed away. WEST COAST CHICK made some contact with the outermost breaker, swung five wide into the lane, lacked a solid offering. REVERSIONTOTHMEAN underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn and gave way. RACHEL'S TEMPER was steadied after stumbling badly at the start and bumping with WEST COAST CHICK, departed the backstretch from the four path and was outrun.
