SISTER STATE assumed a forward position after the start, was patiently handled during the initial stages, stalking the pacesetter from the outside but without applying any serious pressure, resumed the role, but from the three path departing the backstretch, moved up willingly to cut into the leader's margin substantially after halfway around the far turn, got let out and challenged in earnest after settling into upper stretch, drove past FINESSE to take charge with a furlong remaining, stayed in the clear, crossing the finish being briskly hand urged. GALLOPING GIRAFFE got away sluggishly, rode the rail down the homestretch, but raced from off the inside thereafter, remained unhurried for over six furlongs, got asked a response taking the five path for entrance into the stretch, was straightened away and came home with good energy to procure the place. REALLY RIGHT saved ground and proved no match. ASSURED lunged at the start, raced three wide around both turns, spun slightly wider into the stretch, lacked the needed response. LADY KIERKEGAARD off the inside, was no factor. GRAND MERE along the rail and asked for a response after going three-quarters, came up empty. FINESSE rated in the two path to the quarter pole on a loosely-contested lead, succumbed rather readily once challenged.
