VICTORY GALLOP, unhurried on the rail early on, put in a quick three wide run on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished determinedly from the outside and got the nod in a rousing finish. BEHRENS, never far back outside, rallied five wide around the second turn, dug in gamely while inside in the stretch and battled gamely to the finish, just missing. CATIENUS, outrun early, came five wide approaching the stretch and rallied outside to earn the show award. SIR BEAR, never far back, put in a four wide run on the second turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. TESTAFLY, hustled from the gate, chased the pace for three quarters and tired. NITE DREAMER, with the pace while in hand three wide, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. SOCIAL CHARTER quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired after the opening three quarters. CONNECTING TERMS was hard-ridden from the gate, chased the pace along the inside, stopped after three quarters and was eased in the stretch.
