GEORGETOWN bumped at the start, settled between horses early, swung five wide entering the stretch then unleashed a strong late run to win going away. BURGENLAND KID stumbled and was bumped at the start, saved ground while reserved to the turn, swung four wide in upper stretch and finished full of run but could not get up. TOOLS FOR THE JOB settled inside, got through along the rail to take the lead at the quarter pole, battled into midstretch and weakened. SARATOGA SEVEN pressed the pace four wide into upper stretch, gained a slim lead a furlong out and weakened late. ELUSIVE SCHEMES failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. AT ATTENTION chased three wide to the turn and drifted out while tiring. WHY TONTO checked after being bumped at the start, steadied and dropped back on the turn then drifted out while gaining late. STONESTREET SONG set the pace along the inside and gave way in the stretch. BARTLETTS steadied along the backstretch, split horses on the far turn, angled in leaving the quarter pole and faltered late.
