IT'S TEA TIME was steadied while in tight quarters soon after leaving the starting gate, settled towards the back of the pack, was kept in reserve and well in hand for the initial three-quarters, angled out sharply four wide in upper stretch, commenced to rally immediately after being straightened away, charged down the outside of the course with powerful strides, grabbed command and edged away. DOE RUN reserved within range along the outside, entered the second turn from the three path, continued to bide time until nearing the top of the lane, responded positively when given her cue, poked a head in front upon hitting the eighth pole, clung to a narrow margin displaying good determination, was no match for the top one's strong kick, yielding readily, but continued on with good courage to garner place honors. BEAUTICIAN along the inside during the initial stages, maneuvered into the two path midway down the backstretch, sat reserved between rivals during the run around the second bend, made minimal progress while lacking optimal racing clearance, paused momentarily, before beginning a gradual angle to middle of the course, gained sufficient room with a sixteenth to go, then finished with good late burst of energy to earn the show. KITTYLICIOUS taken hold of during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, stalked the leader from the outside, continued that role three wide on the far turn, took off in earnest after turning for home, loomed a serious threat at the furlong marker, but could not sustain the bid. EMPIRE SPRING bobbed at the break, raced within striking distance, displayed a mild rally in the stretch. MUHAAWARA well rated in the pocket, continued to track the leader from that position for over six furlongs, was forced to remain on hold, stuck in traffic, found room to move outward a bit in upper stretch,

closed readily when asked, was still closing in on the front runners when she lugged in sharply, stubbornly resisting strong left handed pressure coming from the jockey, bumping with RIVER FOREST, and ultimately causing that one and BEAUTY IS A BEAST to lose all opportunity, then had no serious stretch offering thereafter. LOXY LADY improved position by weak and troubled rivals in the lane. RIVER FOREST prompted the pacesetter from the outside while under a good hold, made her bid for the lead after entering the stretch, was still in the thick of the fight, when she was bumped and knocked off stride by MAHAAWARA at the eighth pole, losing her best chance. QUEEN HAZEL swung five wide into the lane but lacked the necessary stretch response. SAPPHIRE MINK rank being rated early, settled down upon reaching the backstretch, tired steadily after going six furlongs. BEAUTY IS A BEAST rated on the lead along the inside, was impeded and taken up sharply at the eighth pole, the end result of the chain of trouble began by MAHAAWARA. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run before the result was declared official.
