Footnotes

SINORICE three wide in close range of the lead, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, engaged the leader nearing the furlong marker, battled nose to nose with that rival through the final eighth digging in gamely to just prevail on the line. DAN AND SHEILA set the pace inside under little urging, came under urging at the three eighths pole, edged away slightly to a safe margin, cut the corner into the lane, was confronted by the aforementioned rival nearing the eighth pole, dug in determined fighting on to the wire stubbornly but was nailed on the line and forced to settle for the place honors. MONEY IN MOTION just off the inside in close pursuit, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide for home,

proved no match for the top two while kicking on safely to procure the show. SPRINGCOURT came out after the start bumping with UNGUIDED MISSILE, was checked lightly into the first turn when in a bit tight as PRINCE ARION shifted inside, raced just off inside midpack, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. SPIELBERG saved ground in midpack, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, spun three wide in upper stretch, kicked on with a mild bid through the lane. ESS SHAPE towards the rear saving ground, was asked at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch and passed tired foes in the stretch. SEE ME PROUD three to four wide into the first turn, steadily edged inside getting to the rail at the half mile pole, made some steady progress on the front before flattening out in the final eighth. PRINCE ARION broke in at the start, was urged along in midpack from the seven-sixteenths and weakened in the lane. UNGUIDED MISSILE bumped both sides at the start, was squeezed out after the start, came under a drive at the three eighths while three wide towards the rear and offered no response. BIG CREEK tracked inside under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole and tired. DOUBLESPEAK raced four wide throughout and didn't do a tap.
