**Footnotes**

CYPRESS ISLE settled along the inside soon after the start, was at times lightly coaxed along to keep pace with the embattled threesome a short distance up ahead, briefly abandoned the rail with attentions of splitting rivals from the two path into the stretch, had the attempted move foiled, due to a lack of optimal racing clearance, remained on hold idling within contention near the rail, altered course to be outside all front runners once FLASHY IN PINK was safely by, took off with good energy after the maneuver was completed, sped by all three front runners in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, kicked well clear under good handling. PASSEPORTA stalked the disputed the pace dispute from off the inside, tipped into the three path shortly after CLASSIC POINT edged away to a clear advantage, was asked for run turning for home, failed to keep pace with the top one during the last eighth, continued on well though to win the battle for place honors. FLASHY IN PINK vied from between opponents for nearly a half, appeared shaken off by the widest member of the threesome at the three-eighths pole, staged a mild comeback thereafter for the show. CLASSIC POINT secured a forward post soon after the start, contested for the lead, as the widest of three for much of the opening half, shook free under her own power coming to the three-eighths pole, was guided closer to the rail after having done so, entered the stretch from the two path and holding a comfortable advantage, was cross reined as a cue to go, this being done near three-sixteenths pole, failed to respond appreciably, losing the lead readily during the ensuing sixteenth, got overhauled for good in deep stretch and faltered. SHEILA'S GOLD off a beat slowly continued sluggishly during the initial stages, drifting towards the middle of the strip down the backstretch while gapping the others, remained well off the inside for the run around the bend, asked for some run by the half mile pole, was four wide exiting the turn, failed to have an impact. LUCKY MY WAY tucked along the rail coming to the half mile pole, argued for command with another pair for almost a half, fell back at the midway point on the turn, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, continued tiring.
