Footnotes

CORAIL came away well, showed good speed, moved clear near the seven-sixteenths pole, dictated terms while a bit off the rail on the turn, was asked for more at the top of the stretch, came out some near the three-sixteenths pole, responded well to light right-handed encouragement, disposed of LIQUID LUNCH inside the furlong marker and drew clear under mostly strong hand urging. LIQUID LUNCH chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, moved inside the winner near the furlong marker and proved no match while well clear for the place. GRACEFUL RAGE showed good natural speed, was beaten to the front by CORAIL, eased back behind that rival near the half-mile pole, resisted the tactics of the rider into the turn, came under urging while along the rail, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and failed to match the top two while best of the rest. GIRLUPHIGH (IRE) bobbed at the start, raced just off the pace while off the inside, went three then two wide on the turn and came up empty. KORAT settled on the inside while behind rivals, saved ground on the turn and also came up empty. DIXILUNA bobbed slightly just after the start then brushed with a rival, raced at the rear while behind horses, was rank while in hand from near the half-mile pole into the turn, went five wide on that turn and had nothing left. ZAZZ bobbed slightly just after the start then brushed with a rival, was urged along while off the pace, advanced leaving the backstretch, chased four wide on the turn and capitulated.
