Footnotes

UNBRIDLED COMMAND raced rankly while under stout restraint for much of the way down the homestretch as well as around the first turn, was a little ways down the backstretch before finally getting in harmony to the tactics being applied by the rider, tracked the front runners while sitting a loose pocket, slipped into the two path just before reaching the quarter pole, bided time during the initial portion of the stretch run, found a clearing between rivals by mid lane and only then was given his cue, burst through to go after the leader, reeled in that rival by the sixteenth pole, then dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. GIMME CREDIT was strung out three wide around the first turn, worked out an early tuck closer to the rail while proceeding down the backstretch, remained in the two path until late on the far turn, was taken outward gearing up for the stretch run, eventually settling into the five path by the top of the lane, got straightened away and charged down the outside of the course with strong energy to procure the place. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS three wide around the the first turn, raced one path closer to the rail until the quarter pole, was angled three wide entering the stretch and got called upon, was part of the herd in hot pursuit of BARREL OF LOVE with an eighth to go, came outward one lane after some left handed stick work, causing the rider of POWER BLAST to check, continued onward willingly to grab the show award. AMPERSAND saved ground and held on well to earn the last major check. BARREL OF LOVE bobbed awkwardly at the start, went at it head to head with RUNAWAY JIM briefly proceeding towards the end of the homestretch before eased back, waited for the aforementioned foe to be clear before angling into the two path, sparred for command from the outside, racing on nearly even terms for just over six furlongs, appeared to poke a head in front spinning into the lane, was driven to the lead during the run through the furlong grounds, but with more than half the field in close proximity bearing down hard, relinquished to the top one with about a sixteenth to go and steadily weakened. MODERN CHILD a forward factor from the three path on each bend, folded. SO SCOTT failed to menace. POWER BLAST loosely drafted behind BARREL OF LOVE making his way towards the first turn, became rank upon reaching it, checked and was gradually taken outward just before going a quarter, checked once more about a furlong down the road, was in the four path by midpoint down the back, stayed put there afterwards, being slightly closer to rail only in the early stages of the run around the far turn, managed to stay within striking distance despite the loss of ground, was running in midack down the stretch when checked hard a second time as HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS was crossing over in front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, failed

to regain any real interest. RUNAWAY JIM argued for control from the inside until upper stretch before giving way.
