BEAUTIFUL BUT BLUE assumed a forward position soon after the start, departed the backstretch three wide, perched just off the runner up's hind quarters, crept up to draw abreast about midway during the run around the bend, went at it from that juncture until the quarter pole on nearly even terms with that rival, turned for home and got called upon as a spirited tussle commenced, wrested away the lead and struck the front first at the eighth pole, kicked free the final furlong, kept to a hard drive. RISKY RACHEL put to a firm hold in the initial stages, shook off DEVILISH SPIRIT after going head to head briefly down the backstretch, failed to gain a respite, with the eventual winner making her presence soon afterwards, raced as a team with that opponent from the three-eighths pole onward on the turn, with the rider of each combatant keeping something in reserve, was set down at the start of the stretch duel, fell back a sliver approaching the furlong marker, proved no match thereafter but dug in well to secure second. MISS VALENTINE out a step at the break, was grabbed hold, raced from the outside for just over a half, swung three wide into upper stretch, came home with belatedly foot en route for the show. OPUS A was hustled into midpack, underwent a three wide pursuit while chasing the contested pace around the turn, tired steadily after entering the stretch. GO UNBRIDLED off the inside, was no factor. LADY ON THE RUN saved ground until just before reaching the quarter pole, was asked for some run by the three-eighths pole and for still more spinning into the lane, came up empty. DEVILISH SPIRIT had a ground-saving journey, vied inside with the second place finisher during the initial stages, fighting noticeably on the left side of the bit all the while, began to retreat leaving the three-eighths pole.
