**Footnotes**

DIXIE SPARKLE broke on top and maintained command, cut the pace from the two path, shook away from the closest chasers coming to the quarter pole, spun into the stretch and got set down, remained well in the clear, kept to the task at hand. BLUE SIXTY FOUR got away sluggishly, picked up the pace after going nearly going a half, fanned four to five wide into the stretch, was allowed to drift slightly more running through the furlong grounds, came home with good energy to procure the place, although never posing a threat to the top one. CRAFTY PUSH rode the rail, picked up interest after halfway around the turn, cut the corner into the lane, made up no additional ground from upper to midstretch, held on reasonably well for the show award. MIDNIGHTINPOSITANO gave chase on the winner three wide on the turn under encouragement, was through after completing a half. LITTLE GABBY GIRL appeared unsettled when caught between rivals during the initial stages, brushing with CRESCENT SHORE as a result, raced from off the inside, lacked a late response. LEGAL LADY made light contact with SHALALA leaving the starting gate, failed to reach a contending position. SHALALA brushed at the start, left the five-sixteenths marker four wide, was outrun. FROSTY BUT FUNKY in the four path departing the backstretch, tired. CRESCENT SHORE forwardly placed three wide during the opening stages, retreated during the run around the bend, drifted from well off the inside with little left then got eased.
