Footnotes

ATTRACTIVE RIDE hand urged from the starting gate, worked his way into a forward position, vied for command while taking the two path around the turn, edged away from the closest pursuers nearing the quarter pole, spun into the stretch and was put to a drive, lengthened away during the ensuing furlong, and although geared down in the final seventy yards, was still kept to some light hand urging crossing the finish line. FIDDLERS AFLEET took up the chase on the contested pace from the two path, got roused angling outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch three wide, proved no match. MARILYN'S GUY raced towards the inside, slipped into the two path to clear a fading rival leaving the midway point, continued to fan outward until four wide

by the top of the lane, paused off another before tipping outward slightly more and resuming his rally, went by several rivals to finish a non-threatening third. DEMON'S DEPUTY brushed several times at the start, was slow to settle into stride, picked up interest and followed MARILYN'S GUY off the inside route coming to the five-sixteenths pole, got fanned six to seven wide by the completion of the maneuver, was straightened away and went on to mainly improve position by weak and tired ones. ROMANCING THE GOLD raced along the outside, under some encouragement on the turn, was guided over to the rail coming to the quarter pole, cut the corner and launched a rail rally, couldn't sustain it past the furlong marker and backed away. DE PRICE raced from off the inside and had no rally. WILD TARGET came in, making light contact a few times with BRIAN, pressed the issue three wide on the turn and gave way. DEFINE underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, folded. BRIAN squeezed after being lightly bumped from both sides at the start, went on to save ground to no avail. CASUAL TRICK three wide entering the turn, was five wide exiting it, never reach a contending position and was eased.
