RUN A RISK lost her footing slipping at the start in behind, broke inwards leaning and bumping MOONWALK to recover which in turn caused each rival through to SCENARIO ANALYSIS to be affected trading bumps pinching out ROCK MY HEART to the back, settled just off the inside within aim of the well rated leader, remained unhurried until nearing the quarter pole, got set down at the top of the stretch, rallied with a good kick to confront FREE AS A BIRD through the final furlong, knocked heads with that foe until taking definitive command a sixteenth out and inched away to prevail on the wire. FREE AS A BIRD inherited the lead early into the first turn as the more alertly breaking MALIBU HOLIDAY got taken back inside, slipped away through the first turn and was placed to a firm hold to be well rated on the front, remained under a hold until placed to light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch unleashed, dug in confronted by the aforementioned rival through the final furlong battling head to head for a sixteenth until unable to match strides late, finished with good energy to safely be along for the place. MOONWALK bumped and leaned on at the start when RUN A RISK recovered her footing and in turn pinched back and bumped ROCK MY HEART due to that pressure, raced three wide through the first turn, advanced mildly on the backside, came under coaxing three furlongs out to take closer order through the far turn, continued three wide for home, offered up a mild kick through the stretch for the show. SCENARIO ANALYSIS bumped at the start due to outside pressure initiated by RUN A RISK, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under coaxing three furlongs out, angled four to five wide into the stretch, offered up a mild bid by mostly tired foes to secure the last major share. MALIBU HOLIDAY away sharpest of all at the start, was put to a hard hold and taken back to track the pace inside, got released nearing the far turn before put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. GEISHA GAL steadied a bit in tight between foes near the seven-eighths and into the first turn, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled three wide for home and made no headway. ROCK MY HEART (GER) bumped around then pinched back at the start due to pressure from the outside, was rated two to three wide towards the rear a bit rank under restraint and pulling on the bit down the backside, settled into the far turn, came under urging nearing the head of the lane, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and was unable to make an impact.
