CLOSE CUT, outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn, drew away under steady pressure and widened while being kept to a drive to the finish. DOUBLE GAINER contested the pace while four wide and continued on gamely to hold the place. GOLD STREAMER contested the pace while three wide between rivals and continued on well to the wire. TOMISUE'S PLEASURE contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. FUNNY GIRL contested the pace along the rail and tired in the stretch. PRETTY JOLIE, bumped at the start, chased inside, altered course in upper stretch but had no rally. RAISE was hustled along early, raced inside and had no response. DANCING DIVINITY, bumped at the start, tired badly.
