NANI ROSE raced close up while well in hand, took over from ROSE ESTHER midway on the backstretch, turned back a bid from SOLAR BOUND on the second turn, drew clear when set down for the drive, took a clear advantage into deep stretch then dug in gamely and held off PERFECT STING under a drive. PERFECT STING, never far back along the inside, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely but could not get to the winner. INTRIGUED, rated along inside, rallied on the second turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely from the outside. SOLAR BOUND raced close up early, put in a run for the lead on the second turn but could not get by the winner and faded in the stretch. BELLE CHERIE, rated outside, raced wide and had no response when roused. TWINKLE CREEK, outrun inside early on, came wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. ROSE ESTHER was hustled to the front but was finished after the opening half mile. FIRMNESS raced outside and tired.
