KENDALL POINT broke awkwardly, chased the pace and stayed on gamely to the finish. DREAM TRIPPER set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. MANDAN chased along the inside and tired after three quarters. CROWN DERBY came wide nearing the stretch and had no rally. DEVILISHLY chased the pace while between rivals and tired.
