Footnotes

BETTY'S WISH sprinted clear while setting a brisk pace for the opening quarter was given a breather while in hand along the backstretch, extended her lead on the turn, opened a wide gap when roused in upper stretch the drew off while being ridden out. ALLURING was outrun for six furlongs, closed the gap a bit while four wide on the turn but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. SWEET SCREAMER angled to the inside while unhurried in the early stages, moved up briefly to reach contention along the backstretch but couldn't sustain her bid. PATTIANO steadied along the rail leaving the first turn, was rated along the inside for six furlongs and lacked a further response. MEADOW BELLE rushed up three wide to stalk the pace midway down the backstretch, settled just outside the leader to the turn then tired. SEASIDE DREAM was never a factor. TUNE UP THE BAND showed only brief speed.
