BIRDSTONE settled just behind the early leaders, angled three wide to launch his bid midway on the turn, cruised to the front while in hand at the quarter pole, quickly opened wide gap in upper stretch then drew off to a lengthy score while being ridden out. BOLD LOVE was outrun early, rallied along the rail leaving the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch then outfinished HORNSHOPE for the place. HORNSHOPE raced just behind the winner to the turn, circled four wide leaving the quarter pole, took up chase after the winner in upper stretch then weakened in the final eighth. MY BUDDY MY PAL bobbled then checked slightly while being brushed at the start, raced well back along the backstretch, circled five wide at the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing bid. MONOPOLY MONEY pressed the pace outside the favorite for a half and tired from his early efforts. TEMESCAL RIDGE rushed up along the rail to gain a slim early advantage, dueled along the inside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. TYNAN failed to mount a serious rally. TEN POUND BAY broke a bit slowly, raced five wide to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. SINGLE FILE broke inward at the start then trailed throughout.
