BALLETTO (UAE) trailed early after being pinched back at the start, raced in traffic while moving between horses on the far turn, waited patiently behind the leaders through the turn, rallied along the inside to challenge inside the furlong marker then edged clear under brisk urging. PARAGON QUEEN took the lead midway down the backstretch, set a rapid pace while well off the rail for a half, dug in when threatened while in the four path at the top of the stretch, maintained a clear lead into midstretch, but couldn't hold the winner safe. BRASSY BOOTS raced just off the early pace, angled out on the turn, lodged a mild bid between horses while five wide entering the stretch then lacked a strong closing bid. EXTENT pressed the pace along the rail for a half and tired. SMOKIN SYLVIA stumbled then broke inward at the start, dropped back early, lodged a sharp move while six wide to challenge briefly nearing the quarter pole then flattened out.
