MELLON TURF. (UP TO \$19,000 NYSBFOA) FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake on the turf in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (maiden, claiming, or restricted allowance races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 17, 2004 with 39 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.)



Footnotes

SEDUCER'S SONG was steadied between rivals when in tight quarters entering the first turn, was rated along inside, advanced inside on the second turn, split rivals approaching the stretch, came wide, responded when roused and drew clear late. VENTURI (GB) was steadied along inside on the first turn, saved ground, swung wide entering the stretch and finished gamely outside to get the place award. FORTUNATE DAMSEL raced close up inside, advanced on the second turn, responded when roused and finished gamely while between rivals in the stretch. ART FAN lunged in the air at the start, contested the pace from the outside and stayed on stubbornly in the stretch. LUCIFER'S STONE was rated along while three wide early, angled in on the backstretch, put in a run along the inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. LA REINA contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. DELTA SENSATION was rated along outside, raced three wide on both turns and had no response when roused. GALLOPING GAL dropped back early despite being hustled along and had no response when put to the whip. REALLY AMERICAN was outrun early, raced wide on the first turn, was inside on the second turn and had no rally. SAVAGE BEAUTY was rank under restraint early on, raced between rivals for a half mile and was wide thereafter.
