Footnotes

SQUARE DANCING angled to the rail soon after the start, split horses nearing the far turn, waited patiently while advancing on the turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole, made a strong bid to challenge nearing the furlong marker then drew off while being kept to the task. SUGARLESS raced in midpack while four wide for a good part of the race, closed the gap from outside to take the lead in upper stretch, yielded to the winner in midstretch and continued on well to clearly best the others. DOCSTAR settled just off the early pace, lodged a three wide bid to challenge on the far turn, battled into upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. MOST CHARMING broke slowly, raced in the two path to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. BIRDIE RUN failed to mount a serious rally while wide throughout. CLASSIC EXAMPLE dueled along the rail to the turn and gave way. FACTUAL NUMBER was used up dueling in the two path. ANGEL DANCER was outrun while wide on the turn and drifted out in upper stretch.
