CABAZON steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced in midpack between horses, swung five wide on the turn then closed strongly from outside to get up in the final strides. MOGUL MAN was taken in hand on the first turn, raced up close between rivals, waited patiently on the turn, rallied through a narrow opening to challenge in midstretch, led into deep stretch and was overhauled by the winner in deep stretch. NO MORE GREEN was outrun for six furlongs while racing wide, circled six wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. FITNESS raced in traffic on the first turn, raced in midpack for a half, split rivals on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch then yielded grudgingly. YOUTHETECAN reserved inside, lodged a rally in the two path in upper stretch, and finished well between horses. RIZ SAUVAGE was outrun for a half, rallied along the rail entering the stretch, steadied and altered course at the three-sixteenth pole and rallied mildly in traffic. CINDER CONE broke awkwardly, saved ground for five furlongs, awaited room along the rail nearing the quarter pole, made a run to threaten in midstretch then flattened out. FAIRWAY DRIVE raced six wide throughout and faded in the stretch. HALL OF

FAMER opened a wide gap entering the backstretch, led to the turn and gave way. EXTON was outrun after breaking slowly and raced in traffic at the top of the stretch. QUICK COMEBACK chased the leader for a half, lodged a bid on the turn and gave way. BRIGHT ILLUSION raced up close for five furlongs and faltered.
