PRECIOUS PACKAGE stalked the leader in the three path for a half, took charge in upper stretch and drew off under steady right hand urging. SPANIARD sprinted clear on the rail, set the pace inside, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch and continued on willingly to hold the place. VISCOUNT raced far back for three furlongs after breaking slowly, closed the gap along the rail entering the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and finished strongly. NOWHERE TO HIDE raced in midpack from outside and finish evenly. KEEPING THE HONOR lunged in the air at the start then was pinched back, raced far back for a half, circled five wide into the stretch and passed tiring horses. COACH GRAVY raced in good position behind the two leaders while saving ground to the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. BLANK CHECK raced wide along the backstretch, angled in on the far turn, lodged a mild move at the top of the stretch and flattened out. LUV GOV failed to menace while four wide. FIELDSTONE angled out on the far turn, dropped back at the quarter pole and was not persevered with through the stretch. TUFAO lunged in the air at the start, gave way while wide on the turn and was eased late.
