Footnotes

AL'S DEPUTY was well placed behind the early leader, took charge with a rush nearing the furlong marker and drew off with authority while being kept to the task. HEAVENLY BLAZE was steadied while fractious leaving the gate, rushed up along the inside, settled along the rail to the turn, angled between horses in upper stretch and finished willingly to narrowly gain the place. STAR OF NEW YORK settled just off the early pace, angled between horses at the quarter pole then finished well to gain a share. GOODANDACCEPTABLE sprinted clear on the rail, set the pace into midstretch and weakened. STRUCTURAL CHANGE raced in midpack between horses, lodged a move four wide at the quarter pole and flattened out. JAC ROXS angled in early, moved out four wide on the turn and lacked a late response. IAN KICKS failed to mount a serious rally. JACOB'S DREAM was outrun along the rail.
