Footnotes

ALAJMAL three deep towards the rear initially, progressed steadily through the pack jumping well to move into prominence shortly after fence eight, jumped well over the final fence, collared the leader a sixteenth from the wire and edged clear under a spirited ride. BRAVE PROSPECT showed the front from along the inside jumping well to remain on the front nearly through the entirety, was safely clear in reserve until confronted heading to fence eight, came under urging midway on the last turn, cleared the final fence while confronted and roused, fought on to the line not able to stave off the aforementioned rival's charge while holding on for the place honors in the last jump. MEMORIAL MANIAC inside midpack under reserve, steadily lost some position to fence six before coming under light urging to move into prominence, had the rider get elbowed shortly after fence seven by the rider of THE PRICE OF LOVE as they improved position by fence eight when in tight and just able to squeeze within the jump parameters along the inside, bobbled slightly at the final fence, kicked on mildly and belatedly for the show honors while just missing for the place. THE PRICE OF LOVE jumped well while down inside, had the rider elbow the pilot of MEMORIAL MANIAC just after fence seven when jostling for position prior to fence eight, steadily improved position through the field to the final flight, jumped well at that station and was out kicked through the stretch drive while garnering the last major share. MABOU towards the rear inside, moved into contention for the final fence, was out kicked through the lane and vanned off after the finish. SEER four deep in midpack, came under urging

from just after fence eight and stayed on same pace to the wire. BIRTHDAY BEAU tracked the pace from along the inside while prominent to flight eight and weakened thereafter. BODIE ISLAND raced three deep from just off the pace, came under encouragement nearing the final fence and offered no serious bid in the lane. TRIPPO four deep most of the way, progressed to midpack by fence six before tiring. DR. WHEAT two to three wide towards the rear, never threatened. GRANTOR just off the inside in close range, steadily faded from fence six, weakened, left the course prior to the final flight. QUIET APPROVAL midpack inside, faded from flight six, left the course prior to the final fence.
