BIRD HOUSE made solid contact with POLAN a couple of jumps out of the starting gate, rode the rail, paused in hand momentarily awaiting suitable options coming to the quarter pole, got set down angling into the two path turning for home, kicked into her best stride and was the first to reach the eighth pole, lengthened away, kept to a strong drive. FIFTYFOUR FOREVER was pulling on the left side of the bit getting taken over to the rail, vied with another pair for command for a brief period of time, was taken hold and allowed to drop back slightly, tipped almost immediately to be outside them, chased the embattled twosome, ranged up and issued a challenge coming to the end of the bend, fell back steadily from the winner departing the furlong grounds, held on well though for place honors. SWEET MAXINE briefly involved with the others for command, arrived at the half mile pole, one on one with NOTESFROMABROAD, tucked along the inside, entered the stretch clinging to a slim lead and got set down, surrendered to the winner after going an additional furlong, weakened steadily thereafter. BIT BUSTIN fidgeting about with the head, lost her footing leaving the gate, bumped solidly with the nearest opponent, then went to bump with the same foe very shortly afterwards getting knocked sideways, underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, and tired. MADAME PROSECUTOR bumped more than once from both sides at and just after the start, was steadied and fell back two lengths instantly after the second incident, failed to menace off the subsequent ground-saving journeyh. NOTESFROMABROAD initially involved in a three-way scramble for the lead, continued the fight with SWEET MAXINE arriving at the half mile pole, undertook the task from the two path, with another duo well within range parked to her outside, gave way after turning for home. POLAN bumped just after the start, was placed three wide at the head of the stretch, had no offering.
