SCRIBBLING SARAH had her hindquarters brushed by UTOPIAN WIFE at the start, settled towards the rear, went two then three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, gained ground into the final furlong, rallied under a right-handed whip and closed well to get up late. STOCK FUND settled nicely off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, followed ROSALIE'S PLEASURE into the stretch, raced under intermittent urging while behind the leading duo, hesitated to go between those rivals at the furlong marker, came back under urging, steadied when the hole closed near the sixteenth-pole, surged between opponents late but missed while able to get the place. COURAGEOUS KAREN came away in good order, disputed the pace on the inside, inched clear while cutting the corner into the stretch, responded well when asked for her best, led until the shadow of the wire but was caught while able to hold the show. ROSALIE'S PLEASURE was fractious during the pre-race, raced between rivals while just off the pace then off the rail on the turn, was given her cue at the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch, loomed a threat into the final sixteenth but hung and missed the trifecta. UTOPIAN WIFE brushed with the hindquarters of SCRIBBLING SARAH at the break and was off a bit slow, raced at the rear of the field, went two to three wide on the turn, passed rivals into the final furlong, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and finished with late energy. PIE'S FIRST LADY was urged along on the inside, saved ground while ridden along on the turn and tired. LOVE SCAT bumped solidly with a rival at the start, was well placed while just off the pace, went three wide while urged along early on the turn, angled five wide coming to the quarter-pole and failed to respond. SARAH'S WILD GIRL bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, settled on the outside, went three then four wide early on the turn, angled six wide approaching the quarter-pole and failed to rally. SILENT NO MORE bumped solidly with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn, chased in upper stretch and gave way. BILEAPS AND BOUNDS tracked the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased into upper stretch and came up empty. (Rail at 18 Feet)
