Footnotes

FREIGHT bumped lightly with KITSTRICKORTREAT at the start, was taken outward and placed into the four path nearing the half mile pole, steering well clear as others were intentionally and unintentionally maneuvering to the outside at that juncture, chased the pace kept at a considerate distance from off the rail, arrived at the head of the stretch and challenged in earnest, forged his way to lead by a length with well under a sixteenth to go, came out after

some left handed stick work eventually interfering with FORCE MULTIPLIER by crossing on to that foe's path, finished the final seventy yards under good courage to be the first to cross the wire. FORCE MULTIPLIER bumped soundly with KITSTRICKORTREAT a couple of jumps out of the starting gate, was unhurried from off the inside, picked up interest before getting fanned into the four path by the three-sixteenths pole, was moving willingly when bothered by FREIGHT in deep stretch. DAPPER DRAPER lunged at the break, disputed the pace from between rivals, shook free briefly after leaving the quarter pole, got engaged by FREIGHT and after putting up some fight, yielded to that rival, held on well enough to take the show. SOUTHERN SAFARI away without major incident, veered out in an erratic manner nearing the end of the backstretch, taking FREIGHT along for a short ride, was pulling hard on the bit when angled sharply over to the rail in the vicinity of the half mile pole, stayed along the inside route on the turn and into the stretch, was stuck behind a now-weakening MEL'S DREAM in upper stretch, leaned upon MAKE A DREAM before pushing that one outward slightly but enough to create racing room, got asked for a response and displayed some belated interest. PATTI'S ZIP pressed the issue as the widest of three on the turn and a bit beyond, undertaking the task from the three path, was still in contention when altering course slightly to the inside in midstretch, started backing away after going onward for a few more strides. WOOD ON THE FIRE got pushed on to the overland route by a hard-to-handle SOUTHERN SAFARI approaching the end of the backstretch, managed to make it into the four path shortly afterwards, failed to achieve a contending position. KITSTRICKORTREAT bumped lightly with FREIGHT, bounced off that foe, making much harder contact with the official winner right afterwards, was three wide leaving the five-sixteenths marker, lacked the needed response. MEL'S DREAM dueled for command from the inside, gave way after entering the stretch. MAKE A DREAM gave chase on the front runners from the two path being urged along on the turn, entered the stretch and found himself wedged in tight between rivals shortly afterwards, continued onward under a good hold by the pilot continuing to lack optimal clearance, bumped lightly with SOUTHERN SAFARI then steadied after the same opponent nudged his outward in the vicinity of the eighth pole, lost whatever interest that had remained prior to the latter trouble. SAGUARO BLOSSOM broke on top by a half length, rapidly dropped back despite under some early hand urging by the pilot, trailed while racing from off the inside, turned into the lane under a protective hold. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run, as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of FORCE MULTIPLIER against the rider of FREIGHT alleging interference in the lane, FREIGHT was disqualified from first and placed second for indeed causing interference.
