ROMP AND STOMP raced close up inside while in hand, saved ground on both turns, got through on the hedge in the stretch, dug in determinedly and prevailed after a blanket finish, driving. COZZENE ALONG was rated along early, rallied wide, dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch and just missed. CASTLE SPRING was outrun early, rallied six wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. HARTS GAP raced with the pace while in hand and dug in gamely through the stretch. MONOPOLY was taken back after the start, raced extremely wide throughout and finished gamely from the far outside. AFTER TAXES raced close up inside while in hand, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. VIVA LA STANDARD was outrun early, was steadied entering the second turn and had no rally. MIZ LYNNE KELLY set the pace along the inside and was steadied while tiring in midstretch. JEANNE MARIE F raced inside and had no rally. FIGHTFORWHATSRIGHT chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. ALPINE ROSE raced wide and tired. SIGH OF RELIEF tired after showing brief speed.
