STAKES New York Stallion Statue of Liberty S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD WHICH ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. By subscription of \$100 due on or before December 1, 2003, with the following eligibility payments: \$100 due on or before November 1, 2004; \$250 due on or before March 1, 2005; \$350 due on or before June 1, 2005. \$750 to pass the entry box, \$750 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over in 2006 or three races allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races, 4 lbs.; a race at a mile or over, 6 lbs.; a race, 8 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). Preference to start will be determined by condition eligibility beginning with sweepstakes winners. Ties broken by total earnings. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

PEG'S PRAYER in hand early, was rated along the inside for five furlongs, moved between horses to get out on the far turn, swung four wide while gaining on the turn, altered course to the outside at the three-sixteenths pole, unleashed a strong move to take the lead seventy yards out then was fully extended to hold off FOLLOW MY DREAM in the final strides. FOLLOW MY DREAM bobbled slightly at the start, raced far back for six furlongs, swung five wide on the turn, angled to the middle of the track in upper stretch then finished full of run but couldn't catch the winner. BABY GRAY tucked in a bit approaching the first turn, was hard held while moving out on the backstretch, checked briefly then angled four wide at the five-eighths pole, closed the gap four wide on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch, battled into midstretch and continued on well to gain a share. ARTISTIC EXPRESS settled just off the pace from outside, moved up three wide to contest the pace on the far turn, pressed the issue into upper stretch, gained a slim lead in midstretch then weakened

under pressure in the final eighth. FAIRYTALE STORY raced in midpack while four wide for a half, checked slightly in traffic nearing the far turn, lodged a move four wide to reach contention leaving the turn then flattened out in upper stretch. MY INTERPRETATION dueled along the inside for five furlongs, dug in when challenged on the turn, battled heads apart into midstretch and weakened from her early efforts. LICK THE SPOON steadied and dropped back soon after the start, raced far back while five wide for most of the trip and failed to threaten while improving her position. BELLA ATTRICE failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. POINT ME TO IT checked slightly along the rail on the first turn, settled in good position while saving ground, remained a factor to the turn and gave way thereafter. TAKE CHARGE raced wide throughout. NO REASON checked along the inside nearing the first turn, saved ground and faded after going six furlongs. GONE GOODBYE bobbed at the start, battled along the inside for five furlongs, angled three wide on the turn and gave way.
